

Prayer Guide for Holy Week

Pray for these and other things all week as the Spirit prompts you. Be intentional about setting time aside to pray each day as well. Consider joining others at church in fasting (all or part) of Wednesday to commit to praying for God to move mightily during Holy Week.

Praise/Adoration

- Christ is Risen and gives us reason to celebrate this week
- Jesus is faithful and still reigns as King
- God has given us resources and talents to be able to put this week together virtually
- Though the church building doors are closed, the Holy Spirit can't be confined
- Because we are forced to go virtual, many others will have the opportunity to join us in Holy Week services this year

Confession

- Spend a few minutes confessing our need for Christ and anything else that is keeping you from being in a right relationship with him right now.

Prayer

- Prepare our hearts to be changed by the Spirit
- Many will watch/participate in the services
- The Spirit will convict and draw people in
- People will repent and commit to Jesus as a result
- People will participate in all the services and have a better understanding of what Christ did for us and what he calls us to do
- We will have people wanting to be baptized as a result
- The Church (big C) will be united and see each other as resources to enhance our own ministries and advance the Kingdom of God instead of seeing each church (little C) as competition
- Blinders will fall off our eyes so that we truly SEE Christ and others as he wants us to see him and others
- That we will be bombarded with emails of people who want to know more about Christ and what it means to follow him.
- That our church will be united in prayer like never before and that we will clearly see how God answers our prayers

People

- Make a list of people you know who don't know Christ or who are questioning Christ right now. Pray for them and pray about inviting them to watch our Holy Week services.
- Make a list of people who are not connected to the body of Christ right now and pray for them and invite them to join us in services and hub groups.
